What's it all about?

This diocesan summer camp is being run by Church of Ireland clergy, youth workers and volunteers for young people (post-primary). All adults are Garda vetted and have undertaken the necessary Safeguarding Trust training. There will be plenty of sports, games, swimming, crafts and we also hope to take a trip to an outdoor Adventure Centre during the week. Each evening we will have movies, discos and quizzes with some time set aside for prayer and worship.

What is included?

All meals, activities, and transport costs whilst on the camp.

There is an outdoor swimming pool on site as well as a large sports hall, tennis courts, basketball courts, football pitches and pool tables.

We will hold tournaments and competitions in many of these sports.

What do I need to bring?

- ✓ Torch

Cost?

The camp is €190 per person. The week is heavily subsidized by the diocesan youth grants.

There will be separate boys and girls halls. Bedrooms allow for two people to share each night – please indicate on your booking form who you would like to share with. Bedding is not provided so please bring a sleeping bag and pillow.
